NOTICE OF INTENTION TO PREPARE A NEW ENHANCED PARTNERSHIP PLAN AND SCHEME FOR THE EAST MIDLANDS COMBINED COUNTY AUTHORITY

At its meeting on Thursday 19th February 2026, the East Midlands Combined County Authority approved the commencement of the development of an Enhanced Partnership. In accordance with Section 138F of the Transport Act 2000 (as amended by the Bus Services Act 2017), notice is hereby given that the East Midlands Combined County Authority, in partnership with Derbyshire County Council, Derby City Council, Nottinghamshire County Council and Nottingham City Council, intends to prepare a new Enhanced Partnership Plan and one or more Enhanced Partnership Schemes covering the whole East Midlands Combined County Authority area.

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO REVOKE CONSTITUENT AUTHORITY ENHANCED PARTNERSHIP PLANS AND SCHEMES

East Midlands Combined County Authority and the constituent local transport authorities confirm their intention that, upon formal adoption of the new East Midlands Combined County Authority wide Enhanced Partnership Plan and Scheme(s), all existing Enhanced Partnership Plans and Enhanced Partnership Schemes currently in force within Derbyshire County Council, Derby City Council, Nottinghamshire County Council and Nottingham City Council, will be revoked in full.

The revocation will take effect on the date the new Enhanced Partnership Plan and Scheme(s) are formally made (following statutory consultation and approval processes).

Until the new East Midlands Combined County Authority Enhanced Partnership is formally made, the following Plans and Schemes will remain in force:
